## ADDITIONAL SERVICE OPTIONS

We offer the following additional services, which are optional:

### Additional body preparation services

It is our policy that human remains be identified whenever possible. The identification may be made by anyone who knew the deceased, including a relative, friend, neighbour, co-worker, or clergy person and done in person, online or by photo. Identification of a body is possible with the minimum required preparation, you may wish to consider opting for "basic preparation of remains," as it might afford a more peaceful final viewing experience. One of our funeral directors will be able to guide you on preparation options and make recommendations based on the condition of the body.

**Transportation services to and from a location of a family-led visitation and/or funeral service**

Although a Transfer Service Operator – Class 1 is prohibited by law from arranging, conducting or participating in a visitation, or funeral service at which human remains are present, it may offer transportation services to and from a location of a visitation or service that is led by the family. You may elect to engage the services of our parent company, G.H. Hogle Funeral Home Limited, a Class 1 Funeral Establishment, to assist.

## DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES AND FEES

Any services marked with an asterisk (\*) are the minimum services required to carry out a direct burial or cremation.

**\* Professional and Staff Services (for Minimum Services)**

**\$150**

Professional consultation with licensed personnel, including but not limited to expert advice on options to meet your needs, drafting notices, and advice regarding possible government benefits. Coordination of all activities before, during and after they have been provided by us, and those provided by third-party suppliers, such as the cemetery, crematorium, and media outlets (death notices). Also included are overhead expenses such as maintenance and utilities, accounting and office administration, insurance and 24-hour access to emergency assistance.

## \* Documentation

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate, cremation application or interment permission form. Third-party fees charged for these documents are not included and are itemized below on page 7. Sometimes a provincial "Certified Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available for purchase from the Office of the Registrar General, or through us as a disbursement. We also provide Proof of Death certificates for estate settlement purposes. Proof of Death certificates are provided to the deceased's authorized representative as a service only and are not a legal government document; however, they are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes

This service is a minimum requirement. The body is checked for personal effects (which will be returned to the authorized representative, unless otherwise instructed) and placed into the casket selected. (requires "Facilities for preparation/shelter")

<b>Infectious Case Handling</b>	<b>\$180</b>
Equipment and supplies required for the protection of staff members when caring for decedents who pass away from Vector-Borne, Zoonotic, Blood-Borne, Respiratory and Enteric Diseases identified as Infectious by Public Health Ontario. <b>Sanitary Pouch</b>	<b>\$60</b>
Protective heavy plastic pouch may be required to maintain safe, clean handling of the decedent from the place of death. May be used at the discretion of the staff based on site conditions of the initial transfer of the decedent or for the holding of the decedent in our care	
<b>Extended Sheltering Fee</b>	<b>\$75</b>
Daily charge for a request to hold the decedent in our care for a period beyond the time required to register the death with the Government of Ontario.	
<b>International Shipment Services</b>	
Includes arranging and co-ordination of bringing someone back or sending someone from Toronto, either in the case of the body or cremated remains. This may include coordination with other funeral homes, city, provincial and state governments as well as national and international carriers to facilitate the movement of the decedent from or to outside jurisdictions. This fee <b>DOES NOT</b> include fees for documents, shipping charges, consular fees or any other outside services required to facilitate the shipment.

<b>Special Registration</b>	<b>\$100</b>
Fee for car and staff to delivery Death Registration to local designated Service Ontario Office to expedite the delivery of Government of Ontario Certified Death Certificates. This service is included as part of the more comprehensive "International Shipment Services"	
<b>Attend the Cremation</b>	<b>\$155</b>
Staff attendance at crematorium for requested family witness of delivery to and or commencement of cremation process	
<b>Private Farewell</b>	<b>\$400</b>
A 30 minute gathering for up to 10 people at our facility. No ceremony is permitted. If a ceremony is desired, one may be arranged through our parent company, G.H. Hogle Funeral Home Limited. Your director will be glad to give you a quotation of the cost of your desired service needs.	
<b>Rush Service</b>	<b>\$295</b>
Fee for staff to expedite completion and delivery of requested services within a 72 hour period. The ability to perform this service will be discussed with you by your Funeral professional. This fee <b>DOES NOT</b> include any rush fees levied by any third party (crematorium, cemetery, aquamation provider, government agency, etc.) to facilitate this request	
<b>Medical Certificate Retrieval</b>	<b>\$85</b>
The fee for staff, equipment and time to collect a Medical Certificate of Death that is not made available to the transfer staff at the time of the initial transfer or is not being electronically delivered to us by the necessary authority. Additional mileage rates and distances may apply if necessary - see "Additional Mileage"	

<b>Memorial Tribute Video</b> (150 pictures max. \$0.50 per picture in excess of minimum)	<b>\$135</b>
A great way to capture and remember a life lived. Set to music this cherished keepsake can not only be a main centrepiece of any gathering or service selection but also makes a personal and lasting keepsake for family members	
<b>Picture Scanning Service</b> - Scanning of pictures (up to 150 or part thereof)	<b>\$75</b>

<b>Coroner's Fee</b>	<b>\$75</b>
This is a provincially set fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation or alternative disposition or 'Out of Province' shipping to take place	
<b>Interment/Burial Fee</b>	<b>Varies</b>
This fee is charged by the cemetery for the opening and closing of the grave. The fee varies by cemetery and by the size and depth of the grave	
<b>City Death Registration Fee</b>	<b>\$55</b>
This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death on behalf of the Province of Ontario. The municipality issues a burial permit, then forwards the registration documents to the Office of the Registrar General in Thunder Bay.	
<b>Media Notices</b>	<b>Varies</b>
These are charges for death notices in newspapers, radio stations or other media outlets. Death notices listed on our website are provided to families free of charge

## VAULTS & GRAVE LINERS

Outer burial containers listed below are for standard adult size caskets. Oversize vaults are available to accommodate plus-size caskets. Price includes grave set up and lowering device.

You do not have to purchase a vault unless the Medical Officer of Health has made the use of vaults and grave liners mandatory in the entire cemetery. A cemetery operator may designate a specific area in the cemetery where vaults or grave liners are required; however, the operator must have another area where vaults or grave liners are not required, so that consumers have a choice. A vault or grave liner may be recommended when there are environmental conditions such as poor drainage, or for practical or aesthetic reasons.
